

Subject: Re: Town Council - ERA Delegation Registration - April 16

Lord Mayor and Members of Council:

Enclosed as requested is E.R.A.'s delegation from last night's Council Meeting.

As per our delegation, we respectfully request on behalf of SORE that the Town proceed as soon as possible with the 9/06 evaluation and designation under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act of the Rand Estate at 144-176 John Street.

We also request that the Town proceed with a 9/06 evaluation and associated background research for the properties at 200 John Street and 588 Charlotte Street. We request that the 9/06 evaluation and background research be made available for public review and comment prior to recommendations for designation being brought forward to Council. These properties were part of the original Rand Estate and all elements related to the estate history, including elements of the Dunington-Grubb landscape, should be identified and catalogued before they are damaged and removed.

We also reiterate our submission that a credible heritage impact peer review process will only occur with the early and intimate involvement of your Municipal Heritage Committee with respect to both the terms of reference and the expert selection.
